Kayleigh has reported problem parking that has left the grass verges on the 'Rosies' on Parkside Drive destroyed.

Kayleigh ran a street surgery in the Kents Bank estate to discuss with residents the issue of cars speeding through the estate and using it as a rat run to avoid the traffic lights at the junction of Croxteth Hall Lane and Oak Lane.

Kayleigh been reporting problem parking on Muirhead Avenue East by the Croxteth Park entrance, caused by events in the park

Kayleigh has been out doing litterpicks across the ward including Croxteth Park!

The Lib Dem team work hard and keep in touch all year round. We are always out and about, listening to residents and getting things done.

Labour run Liverpool Council whack over £1000 on your Council Tax bill

Kayleigh Halpin and the Lib Dems have slammed Labour run Liverpool City Council's latest maximum Council Tax rise, calling it 'embarrassing' and 'wrong'.

Kayleigh Halpin said "The Council is charging more and residents are getting less. It isn't fair to local people in West Derby and Croxteth who are already struggling with rising gas, electric and water bills."

The Liverpool Liberal Democrats would scrap Labour's Green Bin Tax - a back door addition to your Council Tax bill. The Lib Dems believe that you shouldn't be paying more and getting less & Council Tax shouldn't increase if you're getting worse services.

...While they give their Councillors a £4million spending spree at your expense

The Labour party have voted to give their Councillors millions of pounds to spend on vanity projects, while at the same time the Council is set to make £20 million in cuts.

Kayleigh Halpin said "we've seen what happens in Liverpool when Labour Councillors give themselves millions to spend on their vanity projects."
