SAFER CROSSINGS COMING

Pushing to keep disruption to a minimum

The junction crossing Melwood Drive towards Barnfield is due to undergo improvement works, with new pedestrian crossings being installed and changes to help manage traffic turning onto Town Row.

This is a busy route for local residents, families and pedestrians, so these improvements should help make the area safer and easier to cross.

Phil Brookes-Lennon and the Lib Dem team are working with the council to make sure disruption over the summer is kept to a minimum while temporary lights are in place, and that residents are kept updated as the works progress.
